


The Archbishop of Canterbury's Lent book for 2024 is 'Tarry Awhile' by Selina Stone –this can be ordered from all good book stores and online.

Mustard Seed Prayer Group—East Bingham Deanery

Lesley Haig, the Lay Chair of our Deanery explains what the Mustard Seed prayer group is about...

What is Mustard Seed? Mustard Seed is a prayer group that meets on the third Tuesday of the month at 2 pm until 3.30pm prompt. Everyone is welcome to join in, more information below.

Jesus said that if you had faith only as big as a Mustard Seed you could ask for what you need and it would be given us. Therefore a small group of us meet monthly to pray for all the churches in our Deanery and for all those leading them.

We ask for God's blessing and his presence to be with everybody associated with any of our churches, we pray for our benefices, our schools and young people and that God would supply our needs as to finance and manpower. We pray for wisdom and strength for all those in leadership. The group usually has seven of us from around East Bingham who meet regularly, but a few more people would be very welcome to join us.

We pray spontaneously for the churches and clergy. Lay leaders known to us are prayed for also as we work our way methodically around the Deanery. We pray for all our churches. There is absolutely no pressure on anybody to pray out loud if you are not comfortable to do so, it's fine if you just want to pray along with us silently.

For the cold winter months we meet at Radcliffe on Trent church rooms, but when it warms up a bit we move around the Deanery to pray physically in some of our churches.
