



Music at East Bridgford


Music comes in many forms from pop to show, to folk to jazz, to classical to operatic and different forms without doubt resonate with each of the readers of East Bridgford Village Magazine. As a listener, we can jump the ages and music can take us back to a special moment in our lives or support fresh memories, behind each of these lovely pieces of music is an artist and musician, a composer and a performer. Some may not know but the beautiful church of St Peter's East Bridgford is home to a group of fabulous musicians which we call 'the choir', but these tight-knit group of people are more than musicians; they have a specific skill and that is to help others to enjoy music within the wonderful, ancient and sacred setting of the church. The music they sing also evokes warm feelings and ranges from supporting a general hymn to singing a delicate psalm or rousing anthem, from ancient to contemporary, but no matter what your religious diversity or beliefs it is absolutely sure to uplift your soul in one way or another. This group of people, our choir, are so musically talented in fact that they can usually sing a piece of music that is put in front of them 'by sight' just by reading the dots on the page, delivering the notes the composer put to paper and ink almost like a 'human jukebox' - put in your pound and they sing! It's really something to wonder at and to be honest this is something that they clearly enjoy too. This mixed group give up their time each Thursday evening for an hour and a half to rehearse their music and deliver it within the structure of a 9:15am Sunday service or a monthly 6:00pm evensong, the latter being where the service surrounds the music which transports you floating from the day into the night. You must really come along and sample this for yourselves and it would be remiss of me not to selfishly plug the fact that we'd welcome more singers, both male and female, to help us do this; basic music reading being a very handy skill for this role of course.

A perfect time to have a go is at Eastertime and you can see below that we have planned a special musical service telling the Easter story in words and music over an hour on Sunday 7th April (4:00pm) at the church where we invite singers (18+) to join us as we work towards this. Treat it as a 'one off' if you like and it will certainly give you a flavour of what and who East Bridgford Church Choir are. We'd also love you to come and experience this amazing story, just turn up in this friendly and welcoming environment, 'grab a pew' as they say and relax into hearing some wonderful texts and gorgeous music of the season! News from our parishes...


